## 2 Engagements and events

## 2.1 Region 6 Stakeholder Symposium

The Region 6 Stakeholder Symposium was held on Wednesday the 25<sup>th</sup> of September in Goolwa South in South Australia. The event was attended by over 70 interested stakeholders from all across the region, who actively engaged and participated in the robust discussions, focusing on working together to secure a freshwater future for the Lower Murray, Lakes and Coorong.

The aims of this Stakeholder Symposium included:

- Developing a shared understanding of State and Federal agency priorities and projects regarding management of the Lower Murray, Lakes and Coorong.
- Finding out what State and Federal agencies would like to see communicated from groups in our region?

- Discussing how Councils and community might best work together to secure a healthy future for the Lower Murray, Lakes & Coorong,
- Identifying how MDA Region 6 can best represent Lower Murray, Lakes and Coorong communities at State & Federal level in the management of Basin resources via the MDA Board.
- Welcome new member Victor Harbour

This was a brilliant event, and I would like to acknowledge the hard work and commitment of Region 6 Chair Cr Melissa Rebbeck and her secretariat Shen Mann for putting this together. The event had a strong narrative flow, and it was a great example of the strength and capacity of our regions.

## 3 National Conference
