The Murray Darling Association explored the Matter of Water at its Basin Water Forum on 2 May 2024, engaging with community and government from across the Murray-Darling Basin.

The Forum explored the Science and Biases in the Murray-Darling Basin, how it affects River Health and the sustainability of Horticulture and Agriculture through the lens of climate change, Flow and Connectivity, Water Economics and Water History.

Over the course of the day, attendees engaged with Guest Speakers ranging from the Irrigation industry, specialists and experts in water, water management, and economics.

Attendees also had the opportunity to explore the future potential of the Wine industry and explore the Biases within the Murray-Darling Basin with numerous Guest Speakers including Fish Ecologist Ian Ellis, Tom Rooney of Waterfind, Kim Chalmers of Chalmers Wine, Fifth-Generation Grazier and Healthy River Ambassador Kate McBride, Orchardist and Conservationist Peta Thornton, and Rosalie Auricht of the Renmark irrigation Trust.

Engaging and networked with peers, Sponsors and Speakers, including representatives from the Mildura Rural City Council, Waterfind, The Department for Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water, the Office of the Inspector-General of Water Compliance, as well as the Mallee Regional Innovation Centre, Attendees discussed and built upon the themes discussed during the Forum, offering a unique opportunity to find solutions, and opportunities within communities!
